2. Fred Dudek reported that training program was being assembled for the Disaster Planning Group. Unified Command appears to continue to be a sticking point with the State Police. Because of the lack of voluntary signatory agreement on the part of town officials to formalize the statewide mutual aid agreement for the Disaster Plan, the state legislature is looking at creating and passing a legislative act. The Group is still looking at how to put together apparatus and personnel assignments. It is likely that this assignment structure will have to occur on a county-basis due to the inability to assign volunteer personnel for extended assignments.
3. Fred Dudek also reports that East Shore Training is now looking at the Columbus Day weekend or later in the fall as new dates for the annual RIT training. The Saturday Incident Command Class will be limited to 16 officers. These 16 officers will be responsible for commanding RIT scenarios the following Sunday.
