Radio Frequency/Communications Committee:

- JT Dunn has asked that the OSFD interior channel be added back to the Valley Shore-wide frequency list. There was discussion / concern that this channel is also used by the Old Saybrook Public Works which would cause an issue during snowstorms or other times when PW could be using the frequency. MMS (Herrschaft / Bauer) that this channel be added as an Old Saybrook Fire interior channel (at OSFD's discretion) but not listed as a Valley Shore-wider interior channel. Motion passed unanimously.
- Sam Baber from Haddam stated that the names for Haddam's channels are not correct on the most recent list.
- Tim Lee stated that Deep River's repeater frequency needs to be added to the list.
- Charlie Greeney asked for clarification on the naming conventions to be sure all departments were following the general Command / Operations structure. Charlie indicated that Chester's frequency names will be changed to align with the rest of the VS departments. He stressed that consistency is key to making this work.
- President Fazzino asked that all Department Chiefs review the list that
 Steve Biasi will send out and get any changes to Steve prior to the
 November meeting. At the November meeting there will be a vote, after
 which each Chief will be asked to sign the approved list prior to
 distribution.

Old Business:

Dispatch repeating of street names / radio transmissions

- President Fazzino indicated that he has noticed a significant improvement since the last meeting.
- Considerable discussion ensued, Charlie Herrschaft will forward Guilford's dispatch procedure for the sub-group to review and make recommendations back to VSMAI.

Plain language

- Charlie Greeney questioned whether we should be looking to change apparatus names / numbers as part of the plain language initiative. Example: Haddam 1-13 would change to something like Haddam Engine 1, Chester 7-6-5 would become Chester Tanker 5, etc.
- President Fazzino asked that we postpone looking at this until after the Radio Committee's work on frequencies has been completed / approved, at which time the Radio Committee will look into this.

 Academy class so all enrollments would go through the Fire Academy.
- Charlie Herrschaft reported that the November RIT class in Guilford is full with 50 firefighters. Charlie encouraged VSMAI members to come and watch the class.
- Gregg Prevost reported that Westbrook is looking to host a CDL class beginning in January. Don Lee will likely be the instructor. More information to follow.
- Charlie Greeney reported that Chester is still looking to host a FF1 class in January. More information to follow.
- Paul Fazzino reported that Essex will be hosting an EMT / MRT-R class the last week in November, weeknights only.

Interest to the Organization:

- Brian Manware reported that Clinton's boat is back in service and their aerial is out of service for an undetermined amount of time.
- Paul Fazzino reported that Essex's new ladder is progressing, estimating that it will be completed January 2010.
- Jim Budney reported that Deep River's new tanker is still being worked on. Could be in service in a few weeks or months depending on whether they decide to paint now or wait. Also need to check with Durham on the tank fill valves.
