Old Business:

President Fazzino announced he emailed the most recent version of the Valley Shore Inventory spreadsheet. President Fazzino explained there are a few towns missing from the inventory spreadsheet and some towns are contained within the spreadsheet that are not part of the valley shore organization. North Madison, Madison and Guilford are missing information from the spreadsheet. President Fazzino requested that each department update the spreadsheet and email it back to President Fazzino. Once all the updated information is received the new spreadsheet with all the updated information will be sent out to all departments.

Lt Paul Fazzino, Jr. of Essex opened discussion on the Rite Rescue System that is a RIT intervention device/equipment. Lt. Fazzino explained he has watched many fire departments train with the device and believes its very useful for RIT operations. Currently, many departments are looking into purchasing the device including Essex, Guilford, Westbrook, and possibly Clinton. The cost of the device/equipment is \$1,200.00 for individual departments, however, if five (5) or more departments purchase the device/equipment together the cost for each department would go down to \$975.00. The device/equipment was present at the meeting for attendees to review and evaluate. President Fazzino explained the flotation part inside the unit was installed for use by the Coast Guard.

Chief Herrschaft of Guilford announced that all Guilford firefighters have been trained on the RIT device. Chief Herrschaft explained he was quite impressed with the device after Tommy Gavin came to his department with the device and demonstrated it's purpose, functions and possibilities.

President Fazzino inquired with the attendees as to whether any departments have conducted any additional instructor training with the burn trailer. Old Saybrook and Westbrook announced they have completed more instructor training on the trailer and now have additional personnel trained to use the trailer. President Fazzino informed individuals that if they need additional training in order to get their personnel trained to call Guilford Fire Department and inquire with Assistant Chief Vetre to get the additional training.

Deputy Chief Minges of North Madison announced his department was looking to get four individuals trained on the use of the trailer
