Deputy Chief Budney stated firefighters and medical personnel had concerns about having their personal information especially medical information placed on the Salamander cards.

Chief Greeney of Chester reported with their department only the chief officers have the passwords to the Salamander card reader and can obtain the personal information in the event of an emergency.

Chief Lee of Deep River stated Judy from the ambulance organization offered to create the Salamander cards for the fire department as long as the fire department provided the materials and supplies.

The attendees then had discussion concerning the colors of the cards.

Chief Dunn of Old Saybrook stated his department does used color coded cards to identify each individual's qualifications.

Deputy Chief Budney reported Deep River is in the process of purchasing a Salamander reader.

Chief Dunn of Old Saybrook stated a meeting was planned for October 23, 2012 at 7:30 PM in Old Saybrook

Old Business:

Discussion was had concerning the burn trailer.

Chief Dunn of Old Saybrook stated he talked to Ray concerning the trailer and the cost to fix it. Ray informed Chief Dunn that it would cost approximately \$20,000 to fix the trailer.

Chief Herrshaft of Guilford stated he talked to Chief Casner about having an individual check the trailer between fire departments. Chief Herrschaft also talked to Chief Casner about raising the cost of using the trailer to cover the maintenance costs of the trailer.

President Fazzino discussed the need for having someone checking the trailer before it leaves each department and added the trailer is a dirt-cheap tool for training firefighters.

Chief Greeney of Chester inquired and questioned the cost to run the trailer besides the rental fee.

Chief Herrschaft of Guilford explained the cost besides the rental fee was determined by how much propane is used during the training sessions. Chief Herrschaft stated some propane companies will donate some propane to fire departments for training use but you would have to check with your local propane companies to see if they would be willing to donate propane and how much they would be willing to donate.

Chief Herrschaft stated the more important issue is making sure the trailer is fully operational when it comes to either your department or valley shore towns and someone needs to inspect the trailer when it moves between towns to ensure it is fully operational.

Chief Dunn reported the burn trailer calendar has been updated to reflect the trailer being out of service.

Chief Herrschaft recommended the valley shore organization send a letter support the rental fee increase to maintain the trailer and having someone inspect the trailer when it moves from one town to another.

Chief Herrscahft announced Guilford will be hosting a RIT course in November but is not sure if it will be Captain Morris or someone else.

President Fazzino announced a pile of equipment for the East Corinth has been donated. Clinton, Durham, Westbrook, and Killingworth have donated equipment.

Chief Dunn of Old Saybrook announced his department had equipment to donate.

Chief Lee of Deep River inquired about how the equipment was being transported to Vermont.

President Fazzino stated East Corinth was traveling down to Connecticut to receive the equipment. President Fazzino announced that if any department has equipment to donate to please let me know.

New Business:

Chief Mike Jenkins of Westbrook announced an upcoming EMT/EMR Refresher training course in Westbrook on November 2nd, 3rd, 4, 17th and 18th.

President Fazzino announced Region 2 has received two Haz-Mat suit per town. President Fazzino recommended and asked the attendees their opinion on having the suits stay with the regional NASH team and if you need support, including the suits, for Haz-Mat incidents the NASH team could respond and bring the suits. A motion was made by Chief Schrempp of Clinton that the Level B suits stay with the NASH team. The motion was seconded by Chief Jenkins of Westbrook. All attendees voted in favor of the motion.

Chief Lee of Deep River announced their department received approval to purchase an aerial truck. The department received approval for \$550,000. Currently, the department has interest in a 2007 American LaFrance/LTI mid

Interest to the Organization:

Chief Schrempp of Clinton reminded the attendees of the upcoming fire seminar being held Saturday, September 29th at the Morgan School. Tickets were still available.

Chief Schrempp opened discussion concerning the use of the tanker shuttle at firegrounds and the need to have a designated radio frequency to straighten out what frequencies to operate on when operating a tanker shuttle operation. Chief Schrempp stated there is not a standardized procedure as to which frequency incoming and home fore departments will operate on when using a tanker shuttle operation and this leads to incoming towns not knowing what frequency to operate on during the tanker shuttle operations.

Chief Dunn of Old Saybrook made a motion that all valley shore towns performing mutual aid operate on the valley shore water supply channel and assign a water supply officer to oversee that channel and water supply operation. Chief Jenkins of Westbrook seconded the motion and the motion was passed unanimously.

Chief Jenkins of Westbrook brought a sample of new K-12 saw blades that Westbrook is using. The blades were available for review at the meeting. The saw blades are manufactured by Desert Diamond Industries. Their website is www.desertdiamondindustries.com
